

2015 SPRING NIHON KAI TOUR

This popular tour covers many interesting cities and sights from Kyoto to the Japan Sea side (Nihon Kai).. Kinosaki, Miyazu, Amanohashidate, Kanazawa, Wajima, Toyama, Niigata, Sado Island, then to Tokyo.

HONOLULU - KANSAI

(1) April 1, Wednesday

Leave Honolulu this morning as you begin your special Spring Nihon Kai tour. Your arrival in Kansai will be one day later due to crossing the Int'l Date Line.

arrive KANSAI - KYOTO

(2) April 2, Thursday

Upon arrival in Kansai, transfer to Kyoto with accommodations at the **NEW MIYAKO HOTEL** or similar.



KYOTO

(3) April 3, Friday (B,D)

This morning take a city tour visiting Tofukuji Temple, Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple, and Kyoto Eigamura (movie studio). Return to your hotel with the rest of the afternoon free at leisure.

KYOTO - KINOSAKI

(4) April 4, Saturday (B,D)

Leave Kyoto this morning enroute to Kinosaki located on the coast of the Sea of Japan. Kinosaki is a pleasant town and very popular as a classic Japanese onsen town. The town is built along a willow lined river and has a charming old-fashioned atmosphere with many traditional houses, shops and restaurants. Dinner and accommodations at **KINOSAKI ONSEN**.



KINOSAKI - MIYAZU - AMANOHASHIDATE - KANAZAWA

(5) April 5, Sunday (B,D)

This morning leave Miyazu and to Amanohashidate. Visit Monjyu Temple then take a boat cruise on Miyazu Bay to Ichinomiya and a cable car ride up Kasamatsu Park for a panoramic view of the Amanohashidate sandbar. Continue for Kanazawa via the Meishin and Hokuriku Expressways. Upon arrival at Kanazawa, tour of the city visiting Kenrokuen Park, Myoryuji “Ninja-dera” and Omicho Food Market. Overnight at the **KANAZAWA SKY HOTEL**.

KANAZAWA - CHIRIHAMA BEACH - WAJIMA

(6) April 6, Monday (B,D)

Morning, proceed to Chirihama Beach and enjoy a thrilling drive on the beach. Then drive along the western coastline of the Noto Peninsula to Noto Kongo, a famous scenic spot noted for its unique rock formations. Continue to Wajima and visit the Inachu Lacquerware Shop. Dinner and Accommodations at **WAJIMA ROYAL HOTEL** (onsen).



WAJIMA - TOYAMA - NIIGATA

(7) April 7, Tuesday (B,D)

Visit the morning market then proceed to Toyama via Himi. Drive to Niigata via the Hokuriku Expressway. You will visit the Furusato-mura Open Air Museum en route. Dinner and Accommodations at **HOTEL OKURA NIIGATA**.

NIIGATA - SADO ISLAND

(8) April 8, Wednesday (B,D)

In the morning transfer to the Niigata Port and for Sado Island by Sado Kisen’s Jetfoil Boat. Sightseeing of the island, visiting the Sado Gold Mine, Senkakuwan Bay, Toki-no-sato History and Legend Museum, Nanaura Beach and Myosenji Temple. Dinner and accommodations at **OSADO HOTEL** (onsen).





SADO ISLAND - NIIGATA - YUZAWA

(9) April 9, Thursday (B,D)

Transfer to Ryotsu pier. Leave Sado for Niigata by Jetfoil. Proceed to Ojiya and visit the Industry Hall to see the Ojiya-chijimi textile on display. Also, you will visit Nishikigoi-no-Sato where Nishikigoi carp are raised. Arrive at Yuzawa spa in the evening. Dinner and Accommodations at **NASPA NEW OTANI HOTEL** (onsen).

YUZAWA - TOKYO

(10) April 10, Friday (B)

Leave Yuzawa for Tokyo via the Kanetsu Expressway. Sightseeing along the way. Upon arrival in Tokyo, visit the Okachimachi Ameyoko Market and Asakusa Kannon Temple with its Nakamise Shopping Mall. Accommodations for two nights at the **HOTEL METROPOLITAN**.



TOKYO

(11) April 11, Saturday (B)

All day free for individual activities. Visit to Shinjuku Gyoen Garden if Cherry Blossoms are still blooming.

TOKYO - HONOLULU

(12) April 12, Sunday (B)

Day free until your evening departure. Leave Tokyo at night for Honolulu. Since you will be crossing the International Dateline your arrival in Honolulu will be on the same day.
